

IF YOUR PEN COULD TALK





- 1. Get a pen or pencil and some paper.
- 2. Find an object in your home. It can be a spatula, a bed sheet, a DVD, a table, a chair, a plant, a sculpture! Play with how big or how small the objects are.
- 3. Write in the voice of that object. What would it say if it only had one chance to speak?
- 4. It can be their secret thoughts and dreams, a bedtime story, an angry speech. The possibilities are endless.
- 5. What would it say to the person that uses it the most? Would it be angry or happy or thankful?
- 6. Read the piece out loud and find their voice and rhythm.
- 7. Keep finding different objects and writing different stories.

You can also:

- 8. Use the object like a puppet, and make it talk! Make sure you choose an object that isn't easily breakable.
- 9. Make different objects talk to each other. What would their interaction be like?
- 10. Place your objects in different locations. What would they say there?
